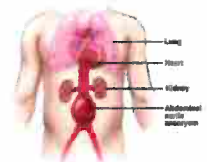

Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm Screening

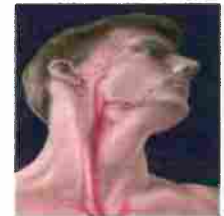

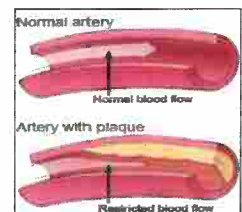
Carotid Artery Screening

Atherosclerosis (Plaque Buildup) can restrict blood flow to the brain or separate and become lodged in a blood vessel, causing a stroke.



Peripheral Arterial Disease (PAD) Screening

Peripheral Arterial Disease, the buildup of Plaque in arms and legs is found in millions of Americans. Non-treatment can lead to a painful, inactive lifestyle and loss of limb.



Peripheral Venous Insufficiency Screening

Venous insufficiency is a condition where the flow of blood through the veins is refluxing causing problems sending blood from the legs back to the heart. This can cause blood to pool in your legs. Non-treatment can lead to swelling, aching, heaviness, varicose veins and/or leg ulcers.
